- **Strict safety protocols** in accordance with Alberta Health guidelines
- **Daily screening** of all participants and coaches
- **Socially distanced classes** (skaters and coaches 2 metres apart at all times)
- **Smaller class sizes**
- **Face masks** required for coaches
- **Cleaning protocols** in accordance with Public Health guidelines

****Skaters must be able to stand up and move forward without assistance, since coaches are not permitted to provide hands-on assistance due to social distancing requirements.**

CanSkate is Skate Canada's learn-to-skate program for beginners. Skaters are taught in a small group by a Skate Canada Certified Coach. Each class will consist of a warm-up, group lesson, and a fun activity.

Equipment required:

- Skaters will need a helmet, skates, warm clothing, and gloves/mittens. For safety reasons, skin should not be exposed.
- Be sure that skates are tightened properly to provide good ankle support.
- Blades should be sharpened before the start of each season. When the skater is not on the ice, wear guards to protect the blades and prevent dulling. When the skater is finished skating, wipe the blades dry with a soft cloth.
- When buying skates, make sure they fit properly and provide good ankle support. To purchase skates or sharpen blades, we recommend United Sport & Cycle (www.unitedsport.ca).

****All skaters must wear a CSA approved hockey helmet (bicycle and ski helmets are not allowed)****



****Skates with laces are recommended (no buckles or velcro)****



Here are a few reminders to help things run smoothly and successfully:

Before the class:

- Please arrive 15 minutes before your class starts to ensure your skater is ready when the class begins.
- Please use your assigned dressing room to change and put on skates; do not use players boxes or ice level seating.
- Once your skater is ready, please line them up at the ice entrance. Coaches will be there to help skaters onto the ice.
- The dressing rooms are busy and have limited space. Each skater should have only one parent accompany them in the dressing rooms. Other family/friends should wait in the viewing area.

During the class:

- Parents should watch the class from the viewing area (at the benches located outside the rink doors at Terwillegar; on the first level at West Edmonton Mall). Please do not stand near ice entrance or stand directly at the boards.
- For safety reasons, parents must be present during class time. Coaches cannot leave the ice to take skaters to the washroom, tie skates, fix equipment, etc.
- Please do not interrupt the coaches or skaters once the class has started.

After the class:

- Come back to ice level a couple minutes before the class is finished to meet your skater as they exit the ice.

Additional Information:

- Please note any cancellation days and arena location changes that are listed in the CanSkate information document on our website.
- Skaters who miss a class may not attend a make-up class on a different day.
- Be sure to read the TV monitor at Terwillegar Rec Centre to check which rink we are skating on. Rinks may be switched without notice.
- In case of a fire alarm, skaters must stay with their coach until the fire alarm has been cleared.
- Some skaters will change groups within the first few sessions as we evaluate the skaters and ensure each skater is in the appropriate group.
- Report cards, ribbons, and badges will be awarded on the last day of each season. Please keep in mind that not all skaters will receive a badge, as it may take more than one season to achieve a badge.
