Welcome to the Ice Palace FSC Spring Classic STAR 1 – 3 Competition. Please see competition details below and let us know if you need any further information or clarification.

Registration: Please report to the registration table at least one hour prior to the start of your event. There will be a separate area at the main Sunsational registration table for the STAR 1 – 3 skaters.

Schedule and start orders: Please see attached for the schedule and for the skater groups/start orders. Please note that STAR 2 and 3 will be using 2 judging panels so that the competition will be continuous from skater to skater – no judging time between skaters is necessary. Please be prepared to take your starting position quickly after your name is called. Please note that we may possibly start events up to 15 minutes early between flood breaks, if all skaters are ready. We will always start events after a flood break at the scheduled time.

If you notice any errors in the events or names on the starting orders, please let us know as soon as possible.

Assessment Criteria: The current Skate Canada Assessment Standards for each level (STAR 1 – 3) will be used to calculate the skater's overall assessment, as well as the individual elements plus Program Components (where applicable). Please note that spins of less than 3 revolutions will be called Bronze in STAR 1 and Invalid (<3 revs) in STAR 2 and 3.

Results: Results will be ready and distributed in the Sunsational awards area by Arena B approximately 20 minutes after the end of each flight.

Music: Please ensure you have a copy of your music on a USB data stick with you at rinkside in case of difficulty playing the music submitted with your registration.

Persons wishing to take photographs or videos are reminded that the use of flash photography is not permitted. The use of video cameras must be restricted to areas that do not disturb or interrupt skaters or officials. Also, please note that you may only take pictures or videos of your own skater.
